Withdrawal of SMPTE ST 429-13:2009

A document should be Withdrawn only if there is a significant possibility of its use causing harm. A Withdrawn document shall still be made available and offered for sale by the Society, but it shall be prefaced by a cover page explaining its current status including a statement that some or all of the content is no longer endorsed by the Society.

ST 429-13 has been integrated into ST 429-2:2020.

Consequently, it is no longer required, will no longer be maintained, will diverge from other documentation and implementation practice, and will harm interoperability.

ST 429-13 should therefore be withdrawn.

Implementers, users, and documentation should instead refer ST 429-2:2020.
